Columbus cancer center gets local help

COLUMBUS -- A cancer care facility has a Chillicothe business to thank for its medical records system.

Advantage Data Systems helped The Mark H. Zangmeister Center, a new full service cancer care facility established by Mid Ohio Oncology/Hematology, with the system, which will be up and running when the center opens Tuesday.

The center is the first of its kind in the state, delivering progressive cancer treatment to more than 16,000 patients annually.

Mid Ohio Oncology/Hematology was able to digitize their paper charts and file them electronically and securely in Cabinet NG, the secure document management software provided by the Chillicothe business.

The biggest challenge, according to local officials, was taking documents from four different locations and moving them into a paperless system.

ADS provided a quality paperless solution in Cabinet NG, allowing medical charts to be scanned into the system using high speed scanners, providing easy access from any computer linked to the network. Cabinet NG also administers user rights, so only authorized personnel can gain access to private patient files.

Patient information including progress notes, images, prescriptions, insurance information, explanation of benefits, and other medical records are saved and filed in an electronic chart.
